Choose your home learning from the menu below:

Write a poem or rap about the Sea or being a castaway. Listen to some examples to help you. You could write your poem inside a wave.

Write a formal letter to Darwin explaining whether you agree with his ideas and why.

Draw a diagram or picture showing the voyage of the Peggy Sue. You can draw or cut out pictures of the places he visited.

Research examples of WW2 propaganda posters. Create your own propaganda poster. Use images, colour and have one clear message

Research Charles Darwin and create a fact sheet. No copy and paste but you can use facts from the internet

Create a comic strip showing the key events of a chapter of your choice. Use pictures and key words

Create a leaflet about evolution by natural selection. Use key terms and make it as interesting as possible

Pick your favourite animal. Find a photo or draw a picture and annotate it to show how it is adapted through natural selection to survive.

Create a 5-10 question quiz about the text or WW2. Write the answers & questions on a different sheet

Create a mind map summarising our topic. Use key terms to make it eye catching
