

Abbey Pupil Survey



Pupils in lower school, upper school and post-16 were interviewed and completed a questionnaire, asking them to rate how Abbey School supported them during lockdown.



95% of pupils said that school supported them.

97% of pupils said they were contacted every week during lockdown.



89% of pupils said they were given work to complete over lockdown. Pupils stated this was either via purple mash, the virtual curriculum or paper copies were delivered.



72% of pupils said they could speak to their school peers over lockdown.

81% said they knew how to use purple mash.



92% of pupils said they were happy to be back at school.

75% said someone in their household had access to the school's twitter
