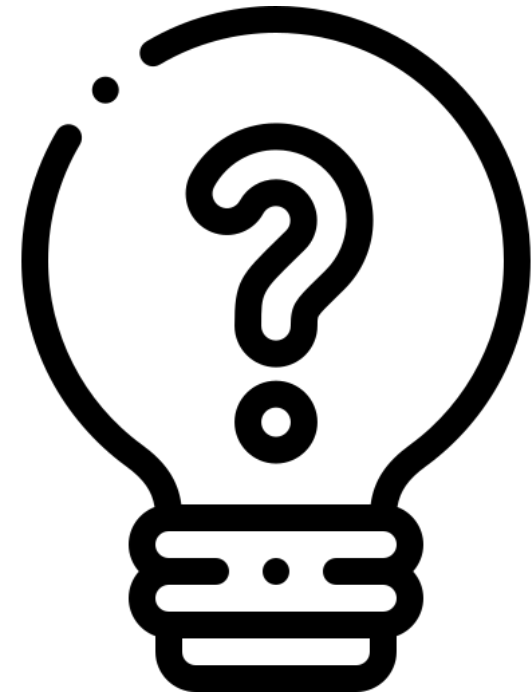




The WAVEE Why?

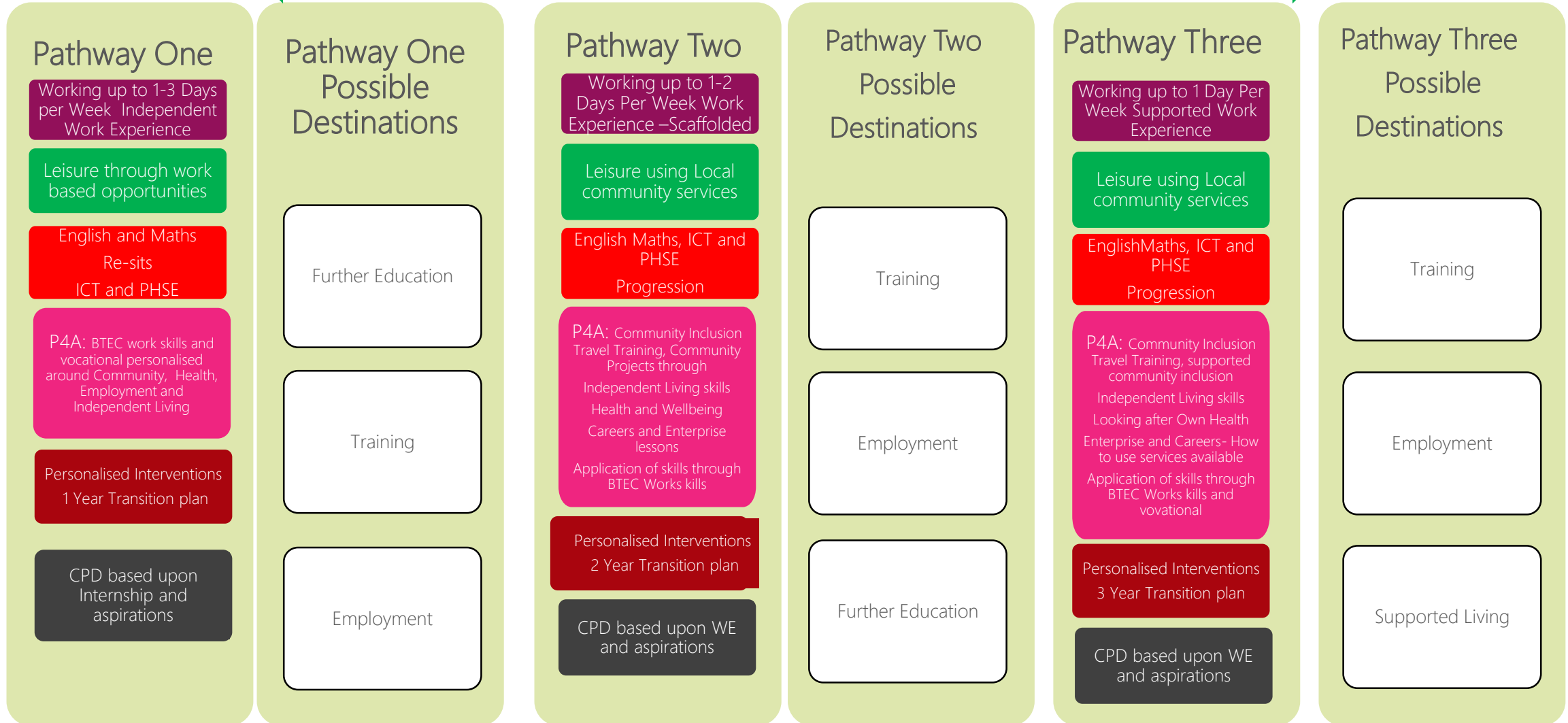
