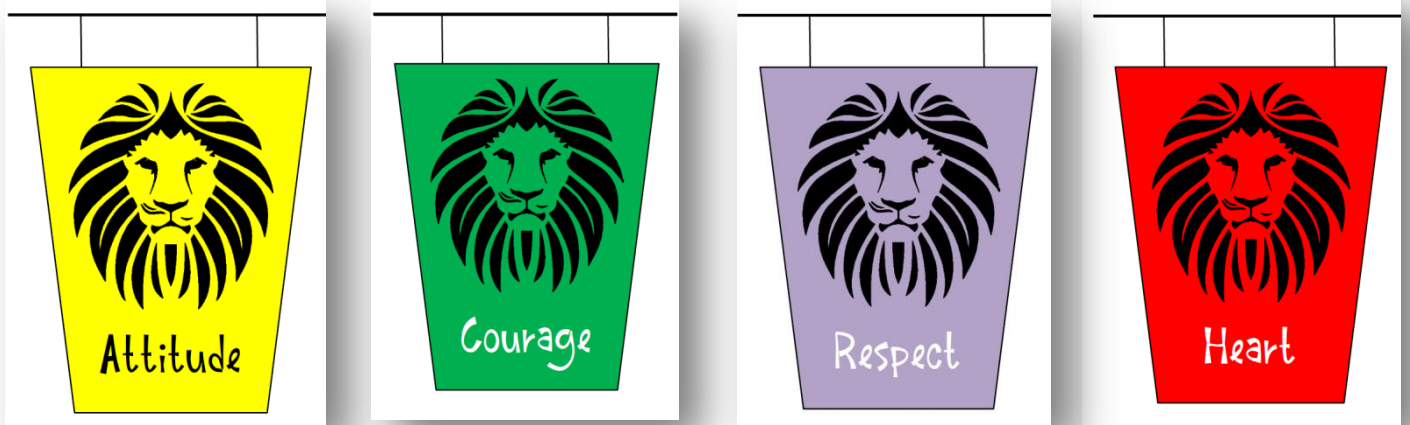


## Lion Leadership at #teamabbey
