What we did and why?



Throughout the year we have listened to you about how we collect family voice. You stated that you would like to be given the option of either completing this digitally or on a paper copy. We have used ended questions that allow you to state your thoughts and opinions, not just being a tick box response. We made the questionnaire anonymous with the option of speaking to staff member if you requested.

As always we based the questions around the four cornerstones of the Rotherham Parents Charter and asked you to comment on school based upon how you and your child felt;

- Welcomed and Cared for
- How communication was with your family
- How we work in partnership with you
- How we value and include you in your child's education.

We asked what was working well and what we could do even better. The results in this little booklet look at just that. What you feel has gone well, what you feel we could do better and more importantly what we have done to address the Even Better If's
